The Acts of the Apostles and the letters to the early church unpack the basic doctrines and ethics of the Gospel. They are written under the authority of our risen Lord Jesus and the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, and they are essential to being a healthy and growing church that does all things to the glory of God.

We recommend these introductory articles from <u>Bible Gateway</u> and <u>The Bible Project</u> as well as the first four chapters of <u>How To Read the Bible For All Its Worth</u>, and consider trying a translation that is less familiar so that you hear it in fresh ways. We encourage using our SOAP Scripture reading method below — Scripture, Observation, Application, Prayer.

SOAP Scripture Reading Method

SOAP stands for Scripture, Observation, Application, Prayer. This is a viewable, doable, and reproducible way of hearing God and doing what he says. It is a simple morning routine you can develop for listening to God's voice and living into his invitations and challenges. This will take you 10-20 minutes.

Sit down for a daily visit and conversation with God. You are here not to complete an assignment but to enjoy an appointment. It is not a task to do, it is a mystery to enter into. It is not about results, it is about relationship. You are not working on a project, you are listening to a person.

Scripture - Listen for the Word within the Word. Within the firm Word of the Scriptures, God has a fresh Word from his Spirit. You may want to read the text a few times, perhaps
